Wolds Ward Laceby Update June 2023

Crime

There have been thirty-seven reported crimes across the Wolds Ward for May. Of these, the following have occurred in Laceby village.

Police have received eleven reports of crime reported by, or involving a male with mental health issues. These calls range from two burglary reports, malicious communications, assault, and public order. These don't take into account the number of other calls received regarding this person's general behaviour and welfare. Your local officers are working with other agencies to try to resolve these issues.

Overnight 30th April & 1st May a moped was stolen from a drive on Butt Lane, after the lock securing it had been cut off. The bike was abandoned on Weelsby Street.

A car was damaged whilst parked at the Royal British Legion club. A female was arrested in relation to this offence.

Other crimes include:

Two other assaults.

One report of sending malicious communications.

One report of harassment.

There were six reports of ASB within Laceby village:

Youths causing issues St Francis Grove x3.

Three in relation to the male previously mentioned in this report.

One neighbour dispute.
