Wolds Ward Laceby Update May

There have been thirty-five recorded crimes across the Wolds Ward for April. There were sixteen reported crimes in Laceby village. Of these, the following have occurred.

A male was arrested for possession of Class A drugs after the vehicle he was driving was stopped on the Barton Street and the items were found following a search.

Other crime include:
Six assaults.
Three reports of harassment.
Two reports of minor public order.
Two thefts.

There was one report of ASB within Laceby village, which was in relation to the Travellers when they arrived in the village.
