Wolds Ward Laceby Update September

There have been forty one recorded crimes across the Wolds Ward for August. Of these, the following have occurred in Laceby village.

During the early hours of 22nd August, there were three attempt burglaries in the village. At a home on Keith crescent, the suspect tried the door handle which was locked. The suspect then moved to a neighbouring home where the van door was tried.

At a home on Charles Avenue, the suspect looked through a ground floor window before trying the door handle, which was locked.

The suspect then went to another home on Charles Avenue and again tried the door handle which was locked.

During the early hours of 27th August, a home on Grimsby Road was entered and a wallet stolen.

As mentioned, during the early hours of 22nd August, several vehicles parked on Keith Crescent and Charles Avenue had their doors tried by a suspect. At one, entry was gained and a clothing was stolen. The remaining vehicles were all locked and no entry was gained.

Other crime include:

- Offenders used a hammer taken from a tractor to smash the tractor steps and side lockers.
- A stone was thrown at a moving car at the Oaklands Hotel causing damage to a window.
- Three assaults.
- Three reports of harassment.
- One report of minor public order.
- There were no reports of ASB.
